

The event will be held Saturday, March 01, 2025 at Washington Park in Brownsville, TX under the Big Tent.

REGISTRATION: The entry fee is \$100 & must be paid at the time of registration. Teams from the previous year have until December 9, 2024, to pay & reserve a designated cooking area from the 2025 event map. Starting December 12, 2024, registration will open to the public for the remaining cooking areas on a first-come, first served basis. Teams will select their cooking area in the order of their paid registration. A map of the Competition Area will be provided at Packet Pick-Up.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please note that the date for the final Registration Drive IS NOT a guarantee that registrations will be accepted until then. We have a limited number of cooking areas available, & once they are filled, no additional teams will be accepted.

<u>UNLOADING OF EQUIPMENT:</u> You will be assigned a specific gate to enter though to unload your cooking equipment. These directions will be provided at Packet Pick-Up. Cookers will have a 15 minute window to unload their vehicles and/or trailers, after which they will be asked to please move their vehicles.

THERE WILL BE NO PARKING INSIDE PARK

COOKING: All ingredients will be inspected before the contest for the following:

- Only PINTO BEANS may be cooked.
- PINTO BEANS MUST BE DRY. PRE-SOAKING BEFORE THE EVENT IS NOT ALLOWED.
 - ONLY after inspection by the Promoters may the beans be washed and/or soaked.
- All other ingredients must be brought to the event raw & uncut.
- Competitors cannot begin cutting / chopping ingredients until the contest officially begins.
- A minimum of four (4) pounds is required & ALL COOKING MUST TAKE PLACE ON-SITE.
- All gas or propane burners & grills MUST BE TURNED OFF at 5:00pm, one hour before the Announcement of Winners.

<u>SAFETY:</u> Charcoal grills & barbecue pits are not allowed. Please utilize a gas or propane burner or grill. Electricity will not be provided & portable generators are not allowed. The Fire Marshall will be present to inspect all areas for open fires & for wood or charcoal Barbecue pits.

FOR THEIR SAFETY, EACH TEAM IS <u>REQUIRED</u> TO HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER ON-SITE
Cooks must prepare their food & cook in the most sanitary manner possible. The promoter reserves the right to inspect cooking conditions at any time during the competition.

<u>SET-UP</u>: Each Cooking Team will be provided with one table & two folding chairs & are encouraged to decorate their cooking area. Teams must not exceed the 10' x 10' space limit, including decorations & structures. Teams may bring one additional table, no larger than 2' x 4', for food preparation. Participants may not use any extra space beyond the designated area. If you infringe on another cook's space or the right-of-way footpath, you will be asked to move. Contestants are responsible for supplying their own cooking utensils & equipment. It is recommended to provide sample cups & spoons for festival-goers to taste your food.



<u>JUDGING:</u> Each contestant will receive an official judging cup & a set of tickets on the day of the event. The two tickets, which have matching numbers, will both be used—one will be securely attached to the cup in a way that hides the number, & the other will be retained by the Head Cook. Winning numbers will be revealed at the Award Ceremony, where the winning teams' numbers will be announced onstage.

Each contestant is responsible for delivering their cup to the judging area at the official judging time. At the discretion of the head judge, cooks may be required to remove the lids from their entries & taste their dish before submitting it for judging. If a contestant refuses, their beans will be disqualified. If a cup is damaged, a replacement can only be obtained if the head cook turns in the damaged cup along with BOTH tickets.

Failure to present your ticket in a timely manner if your number is announced may result in disqualification. Only the Head Cook or the Assistant Cook may present their Team's ticket should they be called, though we encourage all Cooking Assistants to come up on stage for pictures upon confirmation of the winning ticket.

<u>JUDGES</u>: Judges must be 18 years or older & will vote for the chili they like best through a blind taste test based on the following criteria: Flavor, Texture of Beans, Consistency, Blend of Spices, Aroma, & Color. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.** After submission, any cup found to be in violation of the rules will be disqualified at the discretion of the Head Judge.

MISCELLANEOUS: Sombrero Festival is a fun, family-friendly environment. As such, Team Names & Recipe Names are not allowed to be political in nature, vulgar, or offensive. They are also not allowed to be corporate in nature, or an attempt to market any commercial product, good or service. Determination on the appropriateness of any Team or Recipe name is at the sole discretion of Sombrero Festival, Ltd. Names & designs are subject to approval of Sombrero Festival, Ltd.

Any & all items distributed from a Cooking Area, or distributed by a Cooking Team, including but not limited to giveaways, are subject to approval by Sombrero Festival, Ltd.

Any & all items displayed from a Cooking Area, or displayed by a Cooking Team, are subject to approval by Sombrero Festival, Ltd. including but not limited to signs, banners, flags, shirts, cups, placards, etc.



Management Rules

- Sombrero Festival, Ltd is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Decisions made by Judges & Event Promoters are final.
- NO alcoholic beverages or soft drinks may be brought into the park.
- NO concealed weapons may be brought into the park.
- The Head Cook is responsible for:
 - Keeping their area clean & safe
 - The conduct of their team & guests

**Violation(s) of the above rules &/or failure to comply with the rules, regulations or standards established will result in disqualification of the entire team & the entry fee will be forfeited.

Cancellation Clause

The performance of this Agreement by either party shall be subject to force majeure, including but not limited to acts of God, fire, flood, natural disaster, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disorder, unauthorized strikes, governmental regulation or advisory, recognized health threats as determined by the World Health Organization, the Centers for Disease Control, or local government authority or health agencies (including but not limited to the health threats of COVID-19, H1N1, or similar infectious diseases), or other similar occurrence beyond the control of the parties, where any of those factors, circumstances, situations, or conditions or similar ones prevent, dissuade, or unreasonably delay at least 25 percent of prospective Event attendees from attending, or where any of them make it illegal, impossible, inadvisable, or commercially impracticable to hold the Event or to fully perform the terms of the Agreement. The Agreement may be canceled by either party, without liability, damages, fees, or penalty, & any unused deposits or amounts paid shall be refunded, for any one or more of the above reasons, by written notice to the other party.



PACKET PICK-UP: The Cook-Off team will host two Packet Pick-Up events where event T-Shirts for the Cook and the Assistant Cook will be distributed, along with complimentary beverage tickets and wristbands for admission. These wristbands <u>must be worn</u> to gain entry to the park on the day of the event. Cooking Teams will also receive a Map of the Competition Area at this time.
